BIBLE READING

Luke 7:11-23 (Christian Standard Bible)

¹¹Afterwards, Jesus was on his way to a town called Nain. His disciples and a large crowd were traveling with him. ¹²Just as he neared the gate of the town, a dead man was being carried out. He was his mother's only son, and she was a widow. A large crowd from the town was also with her. ¹³When the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said, "Don't weep." ¹⁴Then he came up and touched the open coffin, and the pallbearers stopped. And he said, "Young man, I tell you, get up!"

¹⁵The dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother. ¹⁶Then fear came over everyone, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has risen among us," and "God has visited his people."
¹⁷This report about him went throughout Judea and all the vicinity.

¹⁸Then John's disciples told him about all these things. So John summoned two of his disciples ¹⁹and sent them to the Lord, asking, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?"

²⁰When the men reached him, they said, "John the Baptist sent us to ask you, 'Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?'"
